The will of Edward Bowles Deceased

This will was proved at Sarum on the 11<sup>th</sup> day of January 1853 before the Revd George Lewes Benson Clerk L L B lawful surrogate of the Revd and Worshipful William Edward Hony Clerk B D Archdeacon of the Archdeaconry of Sarum

And by him, Administration of all and singular the Goods and Chattels of the said Deceased, and any ways concerning his Will was committed unto Jane Bowles Widow Relict of the said deceased and the Sole Executrix named in the said Will.

At Sarum on the Eleventh day of January 1853 Jane Bowles the Executrix within named was duly sworn before me

Testator died 9<sup>th</sup> September 1852

This is the last Will and Testament of me Edward Bowles of the Parish of Plaitford in the County of Wiltshire Woodman

I give to my Daughter Charlotte wife of James Suter the sum of Five Pounds. I give to my Son John Bowles the Sum of Five Pounds. I give to my Son Charles Bowles the Sum of Five Pounds. I give to my Daughter Mary Ann Bowles the Sum of Five Pounds. I give to my dear Wife Jane Bowles all the Rents and Profits arising from my Leasehold property called Jones situate at Plaitford afore said during her natural Life and after her death I desire the said Leasehold may be disposed of in the manner that her children may direct and the proceeds to be equally divided between the said John, Charles and Mary Ann Bowles.

All my household Goods & Furniture Farm Stock and Implements with all the rest residue and remainder of my Property whether real or personal I give to my dear Wife during her natural Life and after her death to be equally divided between my said three children John, Charles and Mary Ann Bowles And I also appoint my dear Wife Jane Bowles sole Executrix of this my last Will In Witness whereof I have set my hand this eighth day of May in the year of our Lord One Thousand Eight Hundred and Fifty two
